



Procedure to be Implemented for Persons with Symptoms of COVID-19 In the College of Medicine, University of Ibadan (CoMUI) Work, Learning and Residential Areas

Have you identified a person with a sudden onset of at least one of the following:

- Fever/high temperature
- Recent onset loss of taste (agusia)
- Persistent cough (with/without sputum)
- Congestion/runny nose
- Tiredness
- Sore throat
- Body aches
- Recent onset loss of smell (anosmia)
- Shortness of breath/difficulty in breathing
- Sneezing or wheezing continuously
- Chest pain or pressure in the chest

If "NO" to any of the symptoms

MAINTAIN COMPLIANCE WITH ALL COVID-19 PROTOCOLS AND GUIDELINES

If "YES" to any of the symptoms above, institute the steps below:

1. ISOLATE/SEPARATE THE PERSON

- Observe ALL COVID-19 PROTOCOLS
- Isolate the person in a well ventilated room OR an open space that is at least 2 metres away from the next person
- Obtain information of close contacts

2. INFORM

- Contact the **Head of Department (HOD)** and designated staff/student responsible for COVID-19 concerns
- COVID-19 Monitoring Officers (CMO) for the Department/Unit
- COVID-19 Block and Hall Representatives (CBR/CHR)

3. ASSIST

- Contact Tracing
- Follow the instructions from the Case Management Team

4. EMPHASIZE COMPLIANCE WITH COVID-19 PROTOCOL

- Frequent Hand Washing/Sanitiser use
- Cover your mouth/nose when Coughing and Sneezing
- Ensure face mask covers nose and mouth
- Clean frequently touched surfaces
- Stay home when sick
