Re: Decisions Reached at an Emergency Meeting of the Expanded College Executive Committee on the Health Professional Training Levies for Medical and Dental Students Held On Monday, 19 August, 2019

Please find attached the decisions reached at an Emergency Meeting of the Expanded College Executive Committee on the Health Professional Training Levies for Medical and Dental Students as circulated earlier.

Further to decision 7 on the extract, the portal will be opened to students for payment of the pro-rated levy for the 2015, 2016 and 2017 clinical intakes by Tuesday, 03 September, 2019 and will remain opened for two weeks only.

For avoidance of doubt,

- 2017 Clinical intakes (300 level) will pay Seventeen Thousand Five Hundred Naira (N17,500.00) only.
- 2016 Clinical intakes (400 level) will pay Twenty One Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty Naira (N21,250.00) only.
- 2015 Clinical intakes (500 level) will pay Twenty One Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty Naira (N21,250.00) only.

Kindly provide evidence of payment to the Academic Office for further necessary action.

DECISIONS REACHED AT AN EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE EXPANDED COLLEGE
EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ON THE HEALTH PROFESSIONAL TRAINING LEVIES FOR
MEDICAL AND DENTAL STUDENTS HELD ON MONDAY, 19 AUGUST, 2019


There was an emergency meeting of the expanded Executive Committee which held on Monday, 19 August 2019 to consider the issue of the Health Professional Training Levies owed by the MBBS & BDS Clinical Students vis a vis the memo from the Vice Chancellor to the Provost on the issue. After extensive deliberations, the meeting decided as follows:


- (1) Clinical students in the MBBS and BDS programmes who had protracted programmes at the 300, 400 and 500 levels during the transition between the 2016/2017 and 2017/2018 sessions i.e. 2015, 2016 & 2017 clinical intakes are to pay the prorated sum of ₦17,500, ₦21,250 & ₦21,250 respectively.
- (2) The above prorated levy is to be paid within a period of two weeks following which the results of students who have not paid shall be withheld.
- (3) The Faculties of Basic Medical Sciences, Clinical Sciences and Dentistry will henceforth circulate posting charts to the Financial Controller indicating periods of transition from one level to another, to determine when a new payment for HPTL is due. This will include documentation from the Faculties of the levy to be paid by each student.
- (4) Clinical Students who require additional professional training to meet University requirements shall pay additional Health Professional Training Levies in aliquots of 25% to cover the cost of additional consumables and/or examinations e.g. re-sit examination. This is without prejudice to the Health Professional Training Levies payable for regular training.
- (5) The Health Professional Training Levy paid by Clinical students shall not be on sessional basis but on the training levels of the students.
- (6) The Dean or his representative, in conjunction with Academic Office College of Medicine, will liaise with the Financial Controller to monitor the compliance of students with respect to payment of the Health Professional Training Levy.
- (7) The Financial Controller will activate mechanisms for the students' portal to be re-opened by the ITeMS.


