Dr. Prisca Olabisi ADEJUMO has worked in the area of nursing education and later worked specifically on various conditions of people living with HIV and AIDS till 2004 when she defended her dissertation on Care and Support for People Living with HIV and AIDS (PLWHA) among The Yoruba people of southwest Nigeria in 2004. While working with PLWHA she observed that they are susceptible to some chronic opportunistic conditions and then decided to concentrate on two of these. The first was chronic wounds and later cancers generally as a result of the kaposi's sarcommanoted among them and more specifically to cancer genetics with special interest in genetic counselling of the family members of cancer patients for prompt screening and early detection. She has been a co-investigator and collaborates with colleagues on

a number of projects to establish the UCH Interdisciplinary Wound Care Team and the ongoing cancer risk clinic in UCH. Prisca Olabisi ADEJUMO is a Senior Lecturer at the Department of Nursing, University of Ibadan, Ibadan, Nigeria. A fellow of West African College of Nursing, a certified Wound care Nurse and a Visiting Scholar to the University of Chicago, University of Iowa and University of Pennsylvania, USA at various times. She teaches Medical Surgical Nursing to undergraduate and postgraduate students at the University of Ibadan and her area of research interest includes HIV/AIDS, Wound care and Cancer Genetics with current focus on cancer genetic counselling. She has some publications in peer reviewed journals and has attended several local, national and international conferences and scientific meetings with membership in learned societies.
