- i. Predictive histopathologic features of malignancy in previously diagnosed jaw fibrous dysplasia (FD): Fibrous dysplasia is a benign neoplasm which could undergo malignant transformation on rare occasions. Also, aggressive FD share similar histologic features with low-grade osteogenic sarcoma (LGOS). Awareness of these features can assist in screening for FD cases that may progress to malignancy. This study aims to determine the predictive histopathologic features of malignancy in previously diagnosed jaw FD at the University College Hospital, Ibadan and to introduce a grading index. At present, data collation is ongoing.
- ii. Immunohistochemical expression and serum alkaline phosphatase levels in orofacial bone forming tumours: Alkaline phosphatase (ALP) functions as a hydrolase enzyme for eliminating phosphate groups from organic molecules. It's found in different body tissues as isoenzymes such as the placenta, intestines, kidney, bone and liver. Elevated total ALP activity in serum is seen in bone disorders where osteoblastic activity is increased. Knowledge of the role of this enzyme in tumour formation may assist in suggesting a chemotherapeutic treatment. This study aims to determine the expression of ALP in bone orofacial lesions as well as to determine the serum ALP isoenzyme levels of patients with orofacial bone forming tumours in the University College Hospital, Ibadan. Currently, data collection is in progress
